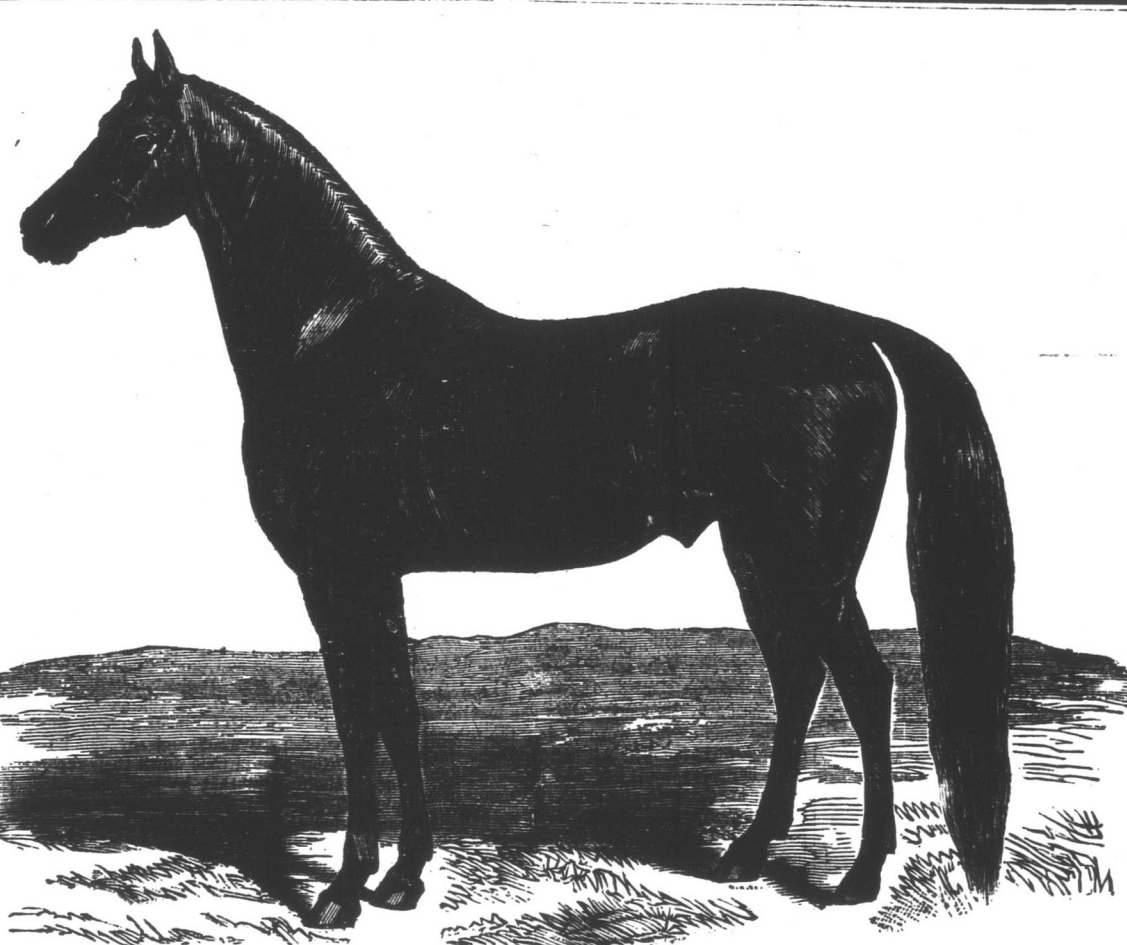

Agriculture

A New Disease.

Mr. A. R. Miles of Margville, Sanbury County writes to the FARMER as follows:—

I am in receipt of a letter of late date from T. C. Miles of Silton, Nova Scotia, who is engaged to some extent in stock raising. In writing of his band of horses he mentions the fact of loss of some of his finest horses by a disease unknown to him in that section of the country, and which they are entirely unable to cure, or in fact to understand. From the description of the disease, and the fact that a part of the stock seemed infected with the disease, and that probably it may spread, I will give you an extract from his letter, giving the symptoms of the disease, and possibly some of our local veterinarians may be able to name the disease, or give some useful information respecting its treatment. The President of a Veterinary College in Montreal, has been consulting with me the diseased animals in Montana for experimental purposes.

Mr. Miles says:—"Last week the best horse I ever raised died of a new disease. It is an affection of the throat and fatal. Neither our territorial or local veterinarians ever saw or read of it, and it is not known over 60 miles of territory, but within that radius, in the last six months, it has killed a large number of horses. This disease has been gone to Montreal this week. I gave lines to a graduate of a college of that place. The President of it had requested him to get two and send on, that they might experiment and learn something of the disease. The animal is first taken with signs of thick wind. (We have no horses here.) It is excited, and the throat will choke and fall, in laboring for breath blood starts from rupturing small vessels in lungs. Over exertion or drinking brings on those spells, which usually last about twenty minutes when the horse dies. There is no discharge, no offensive smell, the animal gains flesh every day, its appetite is good, the horse is in good life and condition. After death, the flesh is natural and nothing is to be learned. Glands are quite present in this territory, but whenever discovered the animal is killed."

Hay and Haying.

Accurate calculations made now make it a great deal of expense and trouble during the remaining months of the year. Nothing pays better than abundance of help in the hay field, especially in unpropitious seasons. There are always stock on the farm which require delicate bites of hay at some time during the winter or early spring months, and the early cut, well cured hay should be set aside for them. It is better to err in cutting the bulk of the hay too early than too late. The early cut is more nutritious and digestible than the late cut, and therefore makes a daintier bite, as well as being a more profitable loss for other foods are scarce, stock will thrive on a minimum supply of concentrated foods, when early cut hay forms the bulky portion of the ration; and when grain is plentiful, large quantities of straw can profitably be fed with hay of this quality.

It is a weak argument to contend that a greater bulk of hay is obtained by late cutting. What is really wanted is the maximum weight of digestible nutriment, which bulk has little to do with. A large percentage of indigestible woody fibre, which has little value either as food or manure. The stock's time should be more profitably employed than to allow them to waste their energies with such indigestible material.

The proper curing of the hay is of about as much importance as the early cutting; for if hay is allowed to wash, it loses nutriment, especially if it is washed in late season. After the hay is washed, place where the crop is to be stored. If on the other hand, the hay, particularly clover, is exposed to the burning sun without being turned or cooked, the stems are dry enough to be preserved. When such hay is handled the leaves break off and are

left on the fields, and with them the most nutritive portion of the plant. The aim in curing hay should be to dry it as evenly as possible, and to preserve it from the washing rain. In the preservation of clover, it is necessary to gather it into heaps after the leaves have become dry, but before they are brittle; by doing this the leaves and outside of the stems will draw out the moisture from the inside and the whole will then have an even percentage of moisture. This is especially necessary for clover, yet grasses will also be greatly benefited by such treatment. Do not cut too large a piece at once, that is to say, so large that it cannot be properly attended to. If the crop is heavy, it is beneficial to turn it several times to aid evenness of drying.

Another advantage in early cutting relates to the aftermath. If the hay field is to be plowed, the second crop of clover, particularly if the
