STRONG MARKET BUT NOT VERY ACT-IVE - VIRTUE LEADS WITH 10 ADVANCE - ELECTRIC STRONGER TO-DAY - A BET AND AN IMPOR-TANT CABLE

Virtue drew a great deal of attention to itself this forenoon in advancing 10 points to 70, a noticeable enough feat in a dull market, where nearly all stocks but itself seemed weaker. The present advancing condition of Virtue was strengthened as an attraction by the prediction of future advances, and advances greater than those of other mining stock.. A memorandum of a bet of \$100 between Mr. R.
