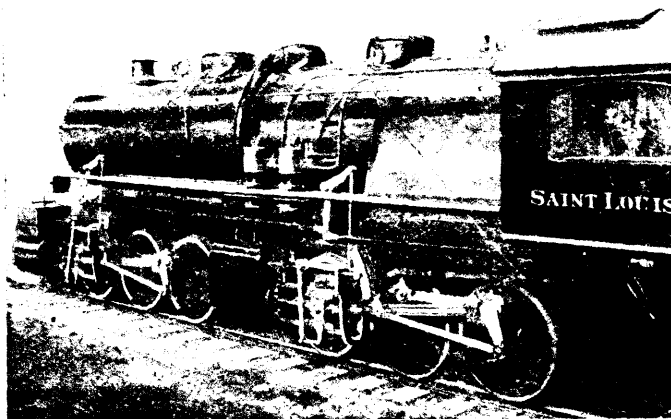


Westinghouse Brakes and Friction Draft Gear
