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DURING the month of February five cargoes of lumber, valued at \$43,229, were shipped from British Columbia, bound for Australia.

THE new SS. Trinidad of the Quebec Steamship Company made her first trip between New York and Hamilton, Berinuda, at the close of last month.

INCORPORATION has been j applied for the "Toronto and Humber Navigation Company," with head-quarters at Toronto, and capital of \$25,000 in shares of \$100 each.

THE sheriff is again in possession of the stock of J. A. Barry, Morrisburg, Ont., for a small claim. Since Mr. Barry was sold out, about 18 months ago, he has not been doing much.

NOTWITHSTANDING the depression in shipbuilding, a Liverpool firm have contracted for two large iron four-masted sailing ships, to carry about 4,000 tons each.

A CONSIDERABLE quantity of shipping, though not large compared with former years, will be launched this season in St. John, N.B., and vicinity and points up the bay.

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
