

2. Items other than those covered by paragraph (1) of this Article shall be subject to this Agreement when the Parties have so agreed in writing.

ARTICLE V

Nuclear material, material, equipment and technology subject to this Agreement shall be transferred from the territory of either Party to this Agreement to a third party only when agreed in writing prior to the transfer.

ARTICLE VI

Neither Party has any plans to enrich to twenty percent or more in the isotope U-235 or to reprocess nuclear material subject to this Agreement. In the event that either Party would like at some future time to undertake such activities, the Parties will promptly hold consultations to agree on a mutually acceptable arrangement. In the spirit of cooperation envisaged by this Agreement, the Parties agree not to act until such arrangement has been concluded. The arrangement shall describe the conditions under which the resultant plutonium or uranium enriched to twenty percent or more in the isotope U-235 may be stored or used.

ARTICLE VII

1. Co-operation under this Agreement shall be exclusively for peaceful purposes.
2. Nuclear material, material, equipment and technology subject to this Agreement shall not be used to manufacture or develop any nuclear explosive device, or for any military purpose.
