Sir:

I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your Note No. FLA-1767, dated December 29, 1978, concerning the Agreement between Canada and the United States of America for Promotion of Safety on the Great Lakes by Means of Radio, 1973, which reads as follows:

In reply, I have the honor to inform you that the Government of the United States accepts the proposals set forth in your Note and the Annex thereto, and further agrees that your Note and this Note in reply shall constitute an Agreement between our two Governments to amend the technical regulations annexed to the Agreement for Promotion of Safety on the Great Lakes by Means of Radio, 1973, which shall enter into force on the date of this Note with effect from February 1, 1979, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article XVIII of the 1973 Agreement.
