CANADIAN DELEGATION TO PRESIDENTIAL INAUGURATION IN COSTA RICA

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, announced today the composition of the Canadian delegation to the inaugural ceremonies of the new President of Costa Rica, His Excellency Oscar Arias Sanchez. The delegation will be led by Mr. Charles Henry Cook, M.P., Parliamentary Secretary to the Secretary of State for External Affairs, who will be accompanied by the Canadian Ambassador to Costa Rica, Mr. Francis Filleul and Mr. John Graham, Director General, Caribbean and Central America Bureau, Department of External Affairs.

The inaugural ceremonies of President Arias will take place in San José on May 8, 1986.
