McDOUGALL HOLDS TALKS WITH U.S. SECRETARY OF STATE JAMES BAKER

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, will visit Washington on Tuesday, January 14, to hold talks with U.S. Secretary of State James Baker.

"I look forward to reviewing a number of major world issues with Secretary Baker," said Mrs. McDougall. The meeting is the latest in a series of meetings between the Minister and Mr. Baker.

Mrs. McDougall will meet with Mr. Baker for a private session and a working luncheon on Tuesday to discuss a broad range of bilateral and international issues. The agenda will include the Middle East peace process and developments in the Commonwealth of Independent States.
