ANNEX A

*Question raised by Mr. Gilbert Parent (St. Catharines)*

What is the cost for the average reserve force man?

**ANSWER**

For Fiscal Year 1976/77, the military personnel costs and the strength estimates are listed below. These costs do not include support of the Reserves in terms of permanent civilian personnel and regular military personnel at armouries and summer camps, pay services, administration etc. Also not included are equipment depreciation and operating costs, the provision of accommodation and facilities and the operation of facilities. These expenditures are very difficult to identify purely for the Reserves since in most instances they are also applicable to the Regular Forces and the Department as a whole. However, as an approximation, if these expenditures were included the figures given for each man for each of the various components of the Reserves should be tripled.
