## ROYAL ROADS COLLEGE—SWIMMING POOL

Question No. 366—Mr. Fisher:

1. Has the military college of Royal Roads a swimming pool?
2. If so, to what size, when and at what cost was it built?
3. During the school year how many students use the pool, at what hours of the week?

Answer by: **Hon. G. R. Pearkes (Minister of National Defence):**

1. Yes.
2. An extension to the gymnasium at Royal Roads, housing a swimming pool, a spectator

gallery, squash courts, locker rooms, store rooms, heating, pumping, filtration and chlorination plants and other facilities was completed in April of 1958 at a cost of \$358,851. The swimming pool measures 75 feet in length and 30 feet in width.

3. As swimming is a compulsory sport at this college the entire student body, consisting of 134 cadets, makes use of the pool. The pool is in regular use throughout the day and evening on Saturdays and Sundays and on afternoons and evenings from Monday through Friday.
