PRAYERS.

Four Petitions were laid on the Table.

Mr. Manion, a Member of the King's Privy Council, presented,—Return to an Order of the House of the 17th May, 1933, for a copy of all telegrams, letters and other documents exchanged since August, 1930, between the Minister of Railways, any official of his department, or between any other federal department and any official of such department, and any other individuals, public bodies, companies or associations, including the railway administration, respecting the repair shops of the Canadian National Railways at Joliette, the Joliette terminal, the contract relating to these shops and this terminal and all other matters connected therewith since August, 1930.

Mr. Murphy, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Governor General,—Annual Report of the Department of Indian Affairs, for the year ended March 31, 1933.
