Ministers not Belonging to the Presbyterian Church in Canada.—Besides the ministers belonging to the Presbyterian Church in Canada, there are in the Dominion about 25 ministers of other Presbyterian Churches. Of these there are in connection with the Established Church of Scotland 4 ministers in the western and 11 in the eastern provinces; and about 10 in connection with the Presbyterian, the United Presbyterian, and the Reformed Presbyterian Churches of the United States.

General Statistics.—According to the Government census the whole population of the Dominion of Canada in 1881 was 4,324,810, of whom the Roman Catholics numbered 1,791,982, the Methodists 742,981, the Presbyterians 676,165, the Church of England 574,818, and the Baptists 296,525. According to the census of 1891 the whole population was 4,832,679, and the numbers belonging to different Churches in the different provinces and territorics were the following:—
