



FOREIGN CROPS

Chicago.

CHICAGO, June 2.—Wheat prices turned upward today, influenced largely by European advices of bullish crop conditions and of diminishing stocks on hand. The market here closed steady at an advance of 4c to 3c net. Other leading staples, too, all showed gains—corn 3c to 1 3-8c, oats 4c to 4c, and provisions 134c to 45c. Damage by drought and high temperature in the southwest and central districts of Russis counted effectively against the bears in the wheat pit. There were prospects also of smaller crops than last year in Houmania and Hungary. Moreover, the world's available supply total had fallen off much more rapidly for the week than at the corresponding time a year ago.

Growing apprehensions as to lack of rain over important sections of the Canadian northwest seemed to offset in a measure the continued excellent general outlook for the United States winter crop.

Notwithstanding a good deal of profit taking by longs, the corn market quickly absorbed all offerings.

Oats trading was chiefly of a local character, with the market firm in sympathy with other grain.

Provisions went upgrade on account of western cut meat stocks having been reduced 10,000 000 pounds during the last month.
