An Act to amend the Criminal Code (Hours of labour)

Loi modifiant la Loi générale du Canada (1949)

Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and of the House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

En Majesty, sur l'avis et du consentement du Sénat et de la Chambre des députés du Canada, édicte:

1. Sub-section 23(1a) of the Criminal Code is repealed and the following substituted therefor:

1. Le paragraphe 23(1a) de la Loi générale du Canada est abrogé et remplacé par ce qui suit:

23. (1a) (a) Every employer who employs or who causes to be employed any person in any business, industry or occupation, with or without pay or with or without a contract, shall not require that person, at any time required by the employer:

(b) work longer or longer hours than those specified in Part III of the Criminal Code (the employer shall have no obligation to carry any obligation referred to in paragraph (a)), with or without pay, with or without a contract, with or without a contract, without pay, for a period or periods including five years.

(2) Every employer who employs or who causes to be employed any person in any business, industry or occupation, with or without pay or with or without a contract, shall not require that person, at any time required by the employer:

(b) work longer or longer hours than those specified in Part III of the Criminal Code (the employer shall have no obligation to carry any obligation referred to in paragraph (a)), with or without pay, with or without a contract, without pay, for a period or periods including five years.
