solved in the Affirmative.

Another Motion was made, and Question put,
That the Copy of the said Freedom be pre-
sented to *John Dunning*, Esq; in a Gold Box,
of the Value of One Hundred Guineas? The
same was resolved in the Affirmative, and or-
dered accordingly.
