REGULATIONS.

SECTION I.

INCORPORATION.

The Canadian Institute is established under Royal Charter, granted November 4th, 1851.

SECTION II.

OBJECT.

The object of the Institute is the promotion of Pure and Applied Science.

SECTION III.

CONSTITUTION.

I. The Canadian Institute shall consist of three classes of members, viz., ordinary members, life members, and honorary members.

2. Ordinary members shall be persons whose pursuits or studies are connected with the Arts or Sciences, or who are desirous of forwarding the objects of the Institute.
