nia, by their act of the second January,  
I yield to the Congress of the United  
States, all right, title and claim which  
I have in the lands north-west of the river Ohio, upon con-  
dition (expressed) that in case the quantity of  
the Ohio, upon the waters of Cumber-  
land River and Tenaflee river, which have  
been granted to the troops upon Continental Establishment,  
be bearing in further upon the Cumber-  
land insufficient for the legal bounties, then  
to lay off the lands, to be laid off  
upon the Miami, on the north-west side of the  
Ohio, which have been engaged to them by the laws

on the 13th of September, 1783, agreed to  
by the several states above-mentioned.
