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KUBANKA WHEAT

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HISTORY.

Kubanka wheat belongs to the amber durum class of spring wheat which was introduced into the United States by the federal Department of Agriculture for the purpose of establishing a class of wheat which would be adapted to the sub-hunnid or semi-arid portions of the Great Plains region. A number of varieties were introduced from Russia near the close of the last century. These were tried out on the experi-ment stations in South Dakota, North Dakota, Montana and other




Fig. No. 1. Kubanka and Other Well Known Varieties.
