

## RESTIGOUCHE WINS AQUEDUCT FEATURE

Was an Added Starter—Jack Atkin Was Second and Rialto Third.

NEW YORK, April 18.—Jas. R. Keene's Restigouche, an added starter, and quoted at 6 to 1, won the Freeport Handicap, 7 furlongs, at Aqueduct today, defeating the Carter Handicap winner, Jack Atkin, on his good race in the handicap, was heavily played, being backed down from a high price to 2 to 1 close at 4 o'clock. Restigouche, who had worked well and was well supported, went back in the lead, but in the stretch Jack Atkin caught him and then began to stop, while Restigouche responded gamely to the whip and won in three lengths. Rialto, the favorite, at 2 to 1, won the Winfield Steeplechase, 2 1/2 lengths.
