

SURPRISES FOURTH DAY AT HAMILTON

Exmer and Broom Corn Pay Longest Prices—Only Two Favorites Win.

Hamilton, June 29.—The Hamilton Jockey Club was favored with a fine afternoon for the fourth day of the meeting and there was the usual large attendance. Seven races were decided with only two favorites winning. Exmer and Broom Corn at \$26.50 were the outsiders to score in the first race. Goldcrest Boy won the Britannia Selling Stakes, the chief feature, handily, drawing away in the stretch. Jack Reeves, second and Alhena third. Sands of Pleasure, the favorite, was never in the running. Lady Lou repeated in the handicap at good odds, David Craig just as easily second and Blaise third. Sincerity, the public choice, landed the first handicap. Hassen crossed his legs and went down in the stretch. The maiden jockeys couldn't handle the short-purloined runners lost their money on Copper King and Ravenscourt. Exmer and Broom Corn paid the highest price for a good thing in the third at \$1.16 miles. Goldcrest Boy, the favorite, won the fourth, coming from fourth position to win going away from Tom Caro and Reginald. Goodwood, the favorite, could never get up. Lady Ward won the closing event at every age. Beauty Spot, second and Apris, third. They still lack Gold Gators, that with Medding Miss carried the bulk of the coin and ran outside the money.
