

White Eagle so as to plough; accordingly I placed three of the men under the charge of each chief. Their spokesman, then pointing to the Red Ensign floating over the wall, asked that the chiefs might be given a flag, as a recognition, which request I promised to report, and which it would be as well to accede to, as it would strengthen the influence of the chiefs.
