WOODSTOCK NEWS.

WOODSTOCK, N. B., May 3.—Wm. F. Dibble died this morning about ten o'clock. About ten days ago he was attacked with paralysis. For a brief period between that time and today he revived a little and it was thought he might partially recover. Yesterday, however, the symptoms of the approaching end became marked and he gradually sank into unconsciousness and passed peacefully away. He would have reached his third birthday had he lived two more months. The greater part of his active life, Mr. Dibble lived in Woodstock, and for half a century his name and figure were alike familiar to the people of the town and county. About twenty-five years ago he established the hardware firm of W. F. Dibble & Son, now grown into large proportions and managed by his son J. T. A. Dibble. Mr. Dibble was an active Free Mason in his day, having been one of the charter members of Woodstock Lodge, and having filled all the high offices in the order. In political sentiments he was a conservative, and in religion a member of the Church of England. He was at church on Easter Sunday and up to that time, unless the weather was very severe, frequently attended both morning and evening services on Sunday. He had been church warden and vestryman. Some years ago he retired altogether to private life, although he remained remarkably strong in body and vigorous in intellect, so much so that it was often remarked that he did not reach the century limit. His was an active, strong personality, and his name will long be remembered in Woodstock as that of an upright and successful business man and an honorable citizen. Mr. Dibble was twice married. His first wife was Mary Barker, by whom he had three surviving children, George, Dibble of Fredericton, and J. T. A. Dibble of Woodstock, were born. His second wife was Miss Clements, who died a few years ago.

The funeral will be at two o'clock on Tuesday afternoon from St. Luke's Church. The Masonic body, of which deceased was long an active member, will attend in full regalia.

# PETER DEVINE CHARGED WITH MANSLAUGHTER.

## Crown Officials Say That Is What Coroner's Verdict Means.

## Inquest in Musquash Tragedy Concluded—Evidence That Devine Hit Mangan, Fell Into Ditch With Him, and Struck and Shook Him Afterwards.

Coroner Berryman and the jury sworn in by him on Monday last to inquire into the circumstances surrounding the death of John Mangan, who was discovered fatally injured in a ditch near the New Brunswick Southern Railway depot at Musquash, April 1st, heard the testimony of eleven witnesses in Knight's hall, Musquash, Saturday. The proceedings are being watched with keen interest.

So far there is little evidence against Peter Devine, the man arrested, many of the witnesses claiming that Mangan and Devine fell from the road to the ditch below while in a clinch. The case will probably be tried this afternoon. All the witnesses examined said that Mangan was looking for trouble and he admitted to Squire Anderson that he was to blame for the affair.

The jury is composed of J. A. Balm (foreman), Fred Clinch, James O'Donnell, John W. P. Corbett, Wm. Thompson and Max Anderson. The hall was filled at both the morning and afternoon sessions. Peter Devine, who is charged with the murder, was present and was seated near him was Daniel Mullin, K. C. Chief of Police Clark and Detective Quinn were also present.

Coroner Berryman thanked the jurors for their prompt attendance. Henry Devine, brother of Peter Devine, the accused man, was the first witness. His testimony was substantially as follows: I am a fisherman and farmer as well. Live at Dipper Harbor, in the parish of Musquash, and work in the Dunn factory. I was in Musquash election day. I saw Henry Devine that day and Mangan. I don't remember the details of the fight, but I saw Mangan lying in the ditch, but did not see him go there. Andrew Shepherd was with me when I saw Mangan. I was in a wagon when I saw him with Shepherd. He was lying on his back. Did not see him move. Did not see him get up. Never saw Mangan five or six years. Never saw him in that position before. Did not know he had been assaulted then.
