

1. That C. P. Wells be permitted to attend college for the purpose of pursuing a post-graduate course of study.

2. That D. E. Martin, T. H. Down, Geo. N. Hazen, John Baird, J. A. Ayearst, and C. B. Keenleyside be permitted to attend college the coming year.

3. That D. E. Martin, T. H. Down, Geo. N. Hazen, and J. A. Ayearst receive full aid from the Educational Fund, as far as the condition of the Fund will allow.

4. That in view of the action of the General Conference, by which the Conference Treasurer is required to forward to the General Treasurer three-fourths of the total collections, instead of one-third as formerly, the Treasurer be instructed, in case of a deficit, to divide the amount left at his disposal *pro rata* among the students entitled to aid.

5. That T. H. Down, G. N. Hazen, C. B. Keenleyside, J. A. Ayearst, and John Baird be appointed to attend Victoria College, Cobourg; and that D. E. Martin be appointed to attend the Wesleyan Theological College, Montreal.

6. That Rev. W. J. Ford, LL.B., be appointed Secretary-Treasurer for the coming year.
