Against Pay by Day
Perth County Council has passed a resolution requesting the Legislature to amend the act, making it original whether members are paid by the day or by session, fees for session not to exceed \$25 and for not more than six sessions a year.

Not Enough Increase
Galt School teachers are dissatisfied with the increase announced by the School Board. The maximum salaries of women teachers was made \$1,100, with a \$100 increase for 1920. Caretakers get from \$1,000 to \$1,350, which is more than the women teachers receive. The board refuses to reconsider the questions. Principals will get from \$1,600 to \$2,000; Assistant Principals, \$1,150 to \$1,450. Mr. Eby of New Hamburg has been appointed to the Central School. In order to save fuel the board has decided to close schools for the Christmas holidays on December.

Tragedy at London
"Good-bye, Nell, and if you want to go to see your mother in St. Thomas it will be all right."
With these words Mr. Leo Sullivan said good-bye to his wife as she left their little home at 267 Waterloo St., London, Ont., about 3 o'clock on Saturday afternoon. An hour later Mrs. Sullivan was cold in death, the victim of an automobile accident at Clarence and Dundas streets, London. Her husband, confident that she was safe with relatives in St. Thomas, did not learn of the tragedy till yesterday morning.

Mrs. Sullivan, who was 23 years of age, was standing near the curb on the southwest corner of Clarence and Dundas, London, when the accident occurred. A car driven by Mrs. Henry Draceley, of Wardville, turned from Dundas east to go south on Clarence. According to eye-witnesses the car grazed one person and then became out of the control of the driver. The result was that it jumped the curb and jammed Mrs. Sullivan, who was in its path, against a telegraph post about eight feet away.


