CIRCULAR.

SIR,

HIS Excellency the Administrator in Chief, wishing that all the inhabitants of the Province be fully informed of what has been done by the Legislature, for the Widows or Relations of the Militia-men who have been killed, as well as for those who have been wounded in an engagement with the enemy, orders me to transmit the inclosed Advertisements to you, requesting that you will cause them to be posted up at the doors of the Parish Church, and further, to distribute copies of the same to all the Captains of Militia of your Parish, informing them of the object in so doing, and explaining to them, that on producing Certificates, such as have been already sent to the different Commanders of Divisions of Militia, they may, in virtue of such Certificates, receive, in person or by procuracy, the sum that the Commissioners appointed by the Act, have allowed them, as well as the Pensions granted them by the Acts of the 43d and 55th years of His Majesty's Reign.

They will apply at the Office of the Adjutant General of Militia at Quebec, who is empowered, by the Act, to pay them the said Pensions, and by order of the Commander in Chief, the said Indemnities.
