- 1—No Petition for any Private Bill, Private shall be received by The House after the Bills, &c., first three weeks of each Session; nor shall receiving. any Private Bill be presented to The House after the first four weeks of each Session; nor shall any Report of any Standing or Select Committee upon a Private Bill be received after the first six weeks of each Session. - 2—The Clerk of The House shall, Clerk to during each recess of Parliament publish Rules resweekly in the Official Gazette, the follow-pecting. ing Rules, respecting notices of intended applications for Private Bills, and in other newspapers (English and French) the sub-
