

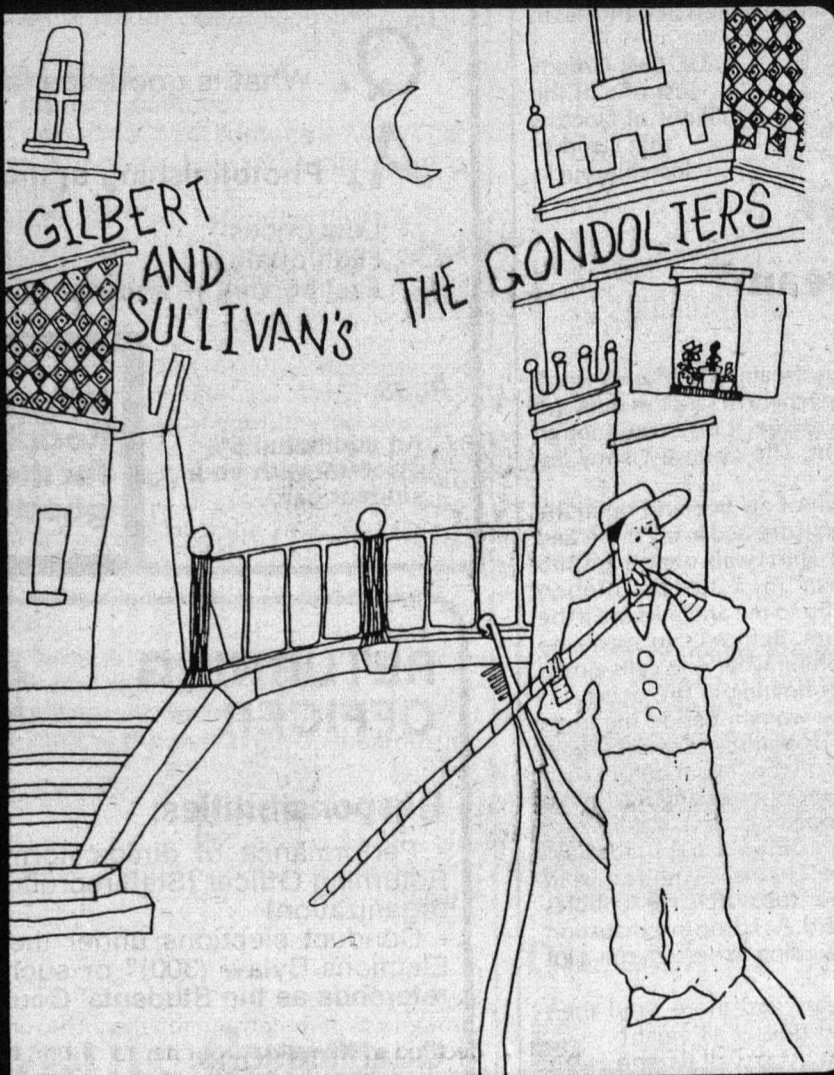

Dean Berg denies the accusation, and says the pot is being grown as part of an experiment.

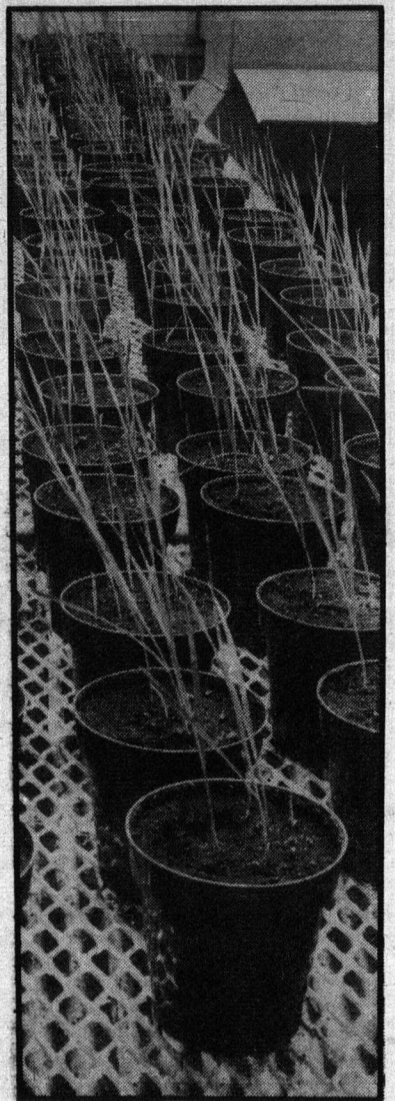
"She (his secretary) is full of it, man. I don't know where she gets all that Lucifer shit," says Dean Berg.

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fucked up we couldn't even move. We just lay there, buzzing out on the spider eating this cricket to my Led Zeppelin album."

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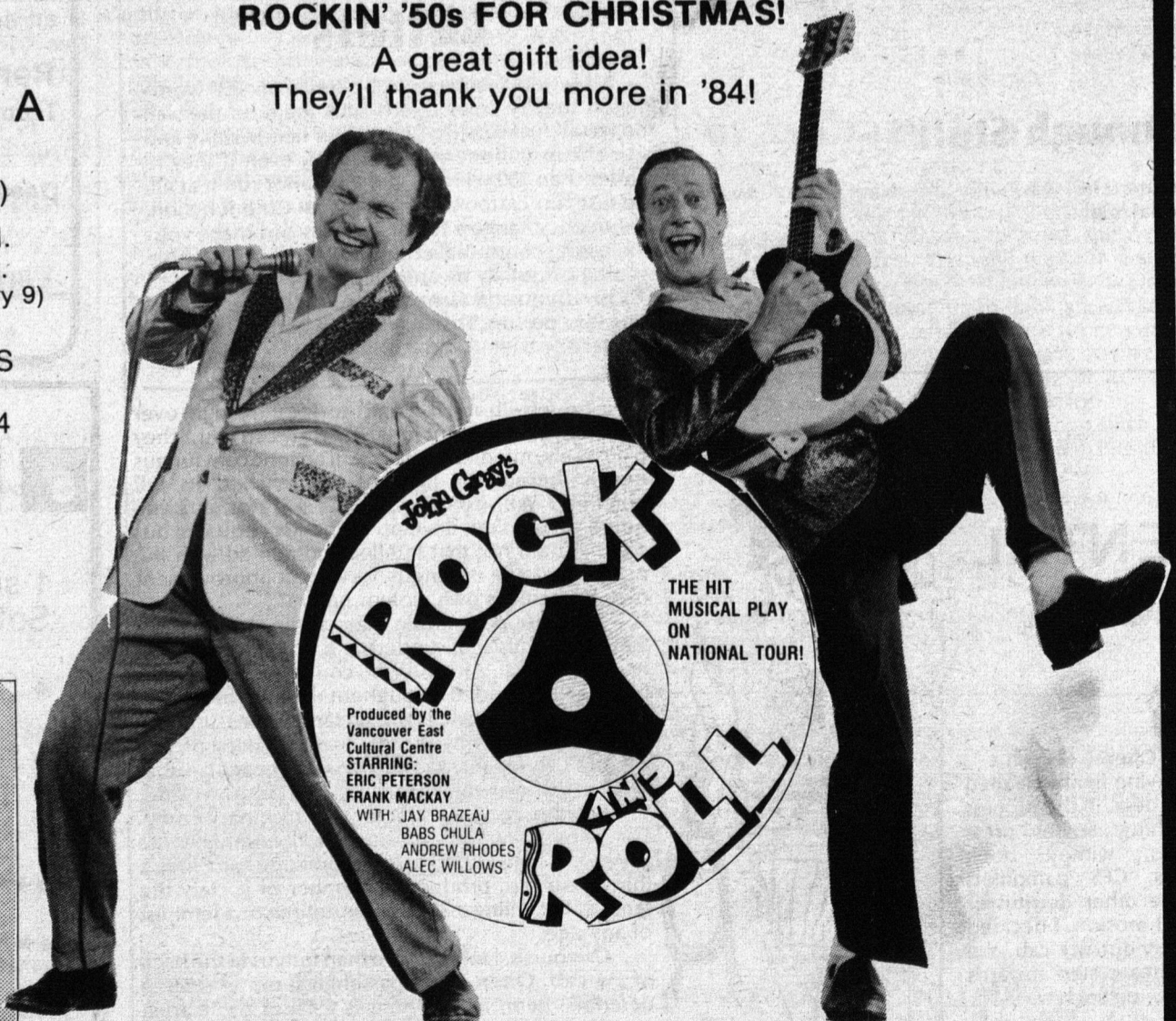
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
