With regard to the first claim
Lt. Governor Archibald states that he
never gave the claimant employment

enquiry to be drunken, reckless
and unprincipled, and that it
would have been unwise policy to
have given him any authority
whatever - but that still he had
some influence altho' more for
harm than good arising from
his living for months together
with
