

parties a recommendation of a member of a Board, it shall be sufficient, as respects the applicants, for the Minister to communicate with the person mentioned in the order as authorized to receive communications on their behalf, and as respects the persons companies or corporations concerned in the alleged combine, with the person, company or corporation mentioned in the order, as the one with whom the Minister should communicate for this purpose.
