

Concerning presents promised
to the Indians of Manitoba and
the Caribou adjacent, who were
parties to the treaties concluded
on the 3^d 21st Aug 1871.

Camp Simpson furnished a
list of presents for the Chiefs &
Councils. They consist of the
following articles which were sent
up in the year 1872:

- 30 Light & heavy Razors
 - 500 lbs of Clothing - Boots & Socks &
Caps - Soap & Medicines
 - At a subsequent period three
more barrels of Simpson
were authorized by the Department
 - 50 Ploughs &
50 Harrows
 - By sanction of our Indian
Council at Winnipeg purchases of
merchandise at Fort Sarry were directed.
 - 500 Spears at \$1.50 — \$750
 - 500 Large Knives at .60 — 300
 - 500 " Axes at \$1.50 — 750
- A supply of Coy this was likewise
authorized
