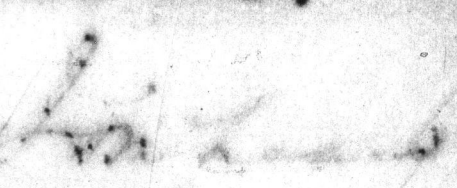
Sir,

I have to inform you that the Department contemplates the erection of a building at the Mount Elgin Indian Institute, to contain a boys' play-room, shower baths for boys and girls and other apartments. I have to request that you will communicate with the Rev. B. R. McVitty, Principal of the school and obtain the information from him necessary to enable you to draw the plans for the proposed building. You should first submit rough pencil sketches, for approval, which may be changed by the Department.

You will be paid at the usual percentage rate on the contract price for plans and specifications, that is $3\frac{1}{2}\%$.

If when the building comes to be erected, it is thought advisable to engage you to superintend the work, you will be further advised.
