



Sir,

I beg to inform you that a complaint has been received from J. E. Favell of Gypsumville, Man., to the effect that you have included in the proposed addition to Reserve No. 48, Section 4, Tp. 32, R. 8, W-1-M, land which had been entered for a homestead by J. C. Favell. He also says that section 32, Tp. 31, R. 8 should not have been included for an Indian Reserve as it is occupied by Peter Anderson. I have to request you to be good enough to report at once at the Department in connection with the above matter and with others relating to your surveys during the past season. I may add that it <sup>is</sup> considered your returns of surveys should have been completed before this and sent to the Department. I have to request an explanation of the delay.
