In further reference to Department's letter of the 29th January and yours of the 6th February last, relative to the supplies required for the Indians at Fort Nelson, B.C., I beg to inform you that the Department has cancelled the arrangement whereby the Rev. G. Gard, Indian Agent, at Fort Simpson, was to make the annuity payments at Fort Nelson.

These Indians will be paid by Mr. Indian Agent Donald, or by Mr. Asst. Indian Agent Laird, of Grouard, Alta., and the supplies should, therefore, be delivered to either of them and the invoices certified by whoever will receive them.
