 that God has spared me for some such service, or
 is it that only through gradual liberation am I to
 reach others the cross to be borne by everyone who
 even touches sin by substitution and vicarious
 sacrifice of soul - a social and spiritual struggle!
 I cannot tell; but I was once broken-soul to take
 my stand, as Paul's stand was taken by Aquinas
 till he became a Paul. Glad I feel for a saint,
 but Aquinas lacks prophetic! Here I stand in my
 Aquinas then last two years and a day! I
 feel sure you will stand by me till I gain my
 feet, and stand upright for service of men and God.
