

- Q. Now, you have said something to the Court about the difficulty of communicating with the Japanese and the fact that Sgt. Harvey was necessarily used as the go-between?
- A. That is quite true, sir.
- Q. And you have given a great deal of evidence covering things that happened in the camp, or arrangements that were made by the Japanese--made with the Japanese, particularly dealing with Red Cross parcels and things like that--working.
- A. Yes, I believe I did make some remarks about Red Cross food, sir.
- Q. And a great deal of the information that you have given to the Court on those points came to you from Sgt. Harvey, did it not?
- A. No, sir. I was present on many occasions with Sgt. Harvey, particularly in quest of Red Cross food.
- Q. Now, Sgt. Harvey suggests in his evidence that he, personally, handled these negotiations with the Camp Commander and he, personally, made the arrangements. What do you say to that?
- A. I suggest that, although he personally made the arrangements, which is quite true, some of these arrangements were made in the "Blue Room" and I was present.
- Q. And how about some of the ones that were made in the Camp Commander's office when you weren't present?
- A. Well, I couldn't have been present then, sir.
- Q. And if you give evidence here of something that happened there it is something that you learned from Sgt. Harvey?
- A. I gave no evidence, sir, of anything that didn't happen in my presence. At least, I don't think I have.
- Q. Now, you said that the Camp Commander came to the "Blue Room" to consume some of this parcel of Red Cross food that was given to him as a bribe and that you had some?
- A. That is true, sir.
- Q. Did Sgt. Harvey have some?
- A. Yes, he did, sir.
- Q. At the request of the Camp Commander?
- A. That is right, sir.
- Q. Did anyone else have some?
- A. No, sir, I can't remember anybody else being concerned.
- Q. And if I suggest to you that that parcel was fully consumed in five or six days--maybe a week--that would be correct, would it?
- A. I wouldn't know, sir. It wouldn't be much more than that anyway.
