- Q. Was it in the morning or afternoon?
A. Afternoon.
- Q. Where was he?
A. Just moving around.
- Q. On the parade square?

- Q. Whereabouts were you?
A. Around the parade square.
- Q. Where was the accused then?

A. I just can't remember the exact time.
- Q. What was he doing? A. Just moving around.
