

- Q.322. You mentioned in your evidence that when your wife went to London the accused was on weekend also. What was the number he left to the Section to be called?
- A.322. It was a Farnham No, I don't remember the No.
- Q.323. You said also that you did not have a pistol at any time so therefore you could not threaten your wife?
- A.323. I meant I had a pistol but...
- Q.324. Did you say in your evidence that you had never had a pistol?
- A.324. I meant in this house.
- Q.325. During the time you have been married have you had a pistol in the place you occupied with your wife?
- A.325. No, sir.
- Q.326. Where your wife and you have been living, have you had a pistol?
- A.326. No, sir.
- Q.327. About those £5. The Defending Offr asked you if you asked your wife for £5 and you said no. You then said you got £5, you did not ask for it. But you stated elsewhere that when you wanted money you always asked your wife to lend it to you. How did you get this £5.
- A.327. I did ask my wife for £5. And she gave it to me.
- Q.328. Is your wife English?
- A.328. Yes, sir.
- Q.329. Where did she live, in Gloucestershire?
- A.330. She lived at Benthend, her parents were in Gloucestershire.
- Q.331. Your wife is a Protestant and you a Catholic?
- A.331. Yes, sir.

BY THE JUDGE ADVOCATE:

- Q.332. The writing on the letters, on the release form, is Lt Haufek. The release form was written by him in front of you, is that right?
- A.332. Yes, sir.
- Q.333. If you had just picked these letters up somewhere and not in your wife's pocket, would you have been able to tell whom they were written by?
- A.333. Yes, sir, I could because I have another letter written by Lt Haufek since those which I have, and it is signed by him the same as the others.
- Q.334. You spoke to Mr. Haufek about them in the office?
- A.334. Yes, sir.
- Q.335. What did he say?
- A.335. He said I love your wife and I will have her some time. He admitted they were his letters.
- Q.336. Who did you report this matter to?
- A.336. I reported it to the CO and he took it up with Legal Aid at CMB.
- Q.337. What happened after that?
- A.337. They called me over there and the next thing I heard I had to report to Mr. Margetts.
- Q.338. Did I understand that you were called to the Legal Aid?
- A.338. Yes, sir.
- Q.339. Did you ask permission to go?
- A.339. I was at the office when the phone call came though, that was after my CO had reported to Legal Aid. And I was told to go and see some officer up there.
- Q.340. The phone call was a result of your seeing your CO about the matter?
- A.340. Yes.
