Synod, when representatives from all the other Dioceses were present in Montreal. The Corresponding Secretary is Mrs. Simpson.

Quebec gives \$300 per annum to the Episcopal Fund, and was asked to contribute \$500 per annum to our Missions. Out of \$625 thus due for the fifteen months ending October 1st, last, she has paid \$597 01.* Our Corresponding Secretary is the Rev. J. Walters.

New Brunswick has contributed \$254 52 to the support of our Missions. The Corresponding Secretary is the Rev. T. E. Dowling.

Nova Scotia has contributed to our Mission Fund the sum of \$161 35.
