

The Duke of Portland, who is the largest landowner in the district, has been a generous contributor to the funds, heading the list of donations with 500l. The foundation-stone of the new church, which will provide immediate accommodation for 320 worshippers, with the possibility of extending it to 500, was laid in October by the Duchess of Portland.
