Robertson, who recent-ly toured Britain, France and Italy, on behalf of the Canadian government and the Canadian Food Board, reports onditions in Italy as extremely severe, although improved by good crops of fruit and vegetables during the past ummer. There has been a diminution of over 50 per sent in the production of orer 50 per sent in the production of milk, butter and cheese, and the total ration in Germany, according to the Italians Food Controller, was better at the time of Dr. Robertson's visit than that of Italy.
