been graciously pleased to order, that the casual and territorial revenue be applied towards defraying the civil expences of the Province; and by the same Message His Excellency recommends to this House, to take measures to relieve the subject by other duties, if raising the Lots et Ventes, Droit de quint &c. up to the legal standard; would prove oppressive to the people.

And the question being put thereon, the House divided, and the same being carried in the affirmative by a Majority of sixteen, in consequence—

Ordered, that the first section of His Excellency the Governor's Message to this House, of the 29th of April last, be referred to the Committee of the whole House on Monday the second of March next.

Then on motion of Mr. Bertbelot, seconded by Mr. Olivier, Adjourned till Monday next at one o'clock in the afternoon.
