

WILL SUE FOR PEACE.

OPERATIONS IN DARDANELLES.

LONDON, March 26. The British battleships Queen Elizabeth and Agamemnon and the ruiser Cornwall, entered the Dardanelles Straits on Wednesday night to protect mine sweepers, according to a despatch to Reuter's Telegram Company from the Island of Tenedos, dated Thursday. The Turkish artillery at Erenkui fired five shells, and the forts at Kilid Bahr also fired on the British vessels, which replied with twenty rounds. To this the Turks made no reply. From midnight until morning the sweepers continued their work without disturbance, the correspondent says, with ery satisfactory results.

ANOTHER STEAMER SUNK.

LONDON, March 26. The steamer Delmira has been sunk by a German submarine off Boulogne, in the English Channel. The members of the crew were given ten minutes to leave the vessel. Subsequently they landed on the Isle of Wight. The Delmira, a British steamer of 2,011 tons net, was engaged in trans-Atlantic trade, and arrived at Havre from St. John, N.B., on March 14th.


