Twenty Years in Prison. Chicago, Aug. 30.—William D. Haywood, "Uncrowned King" of the Industrial Workers of the World, and fourteen of his chief aides in the conspiracy to overturn the American programme, were sentenced to twenty years in the Federal Penitentiary at Leavenworth, Kansas, by Federal Judge K. M. Landis, here late to-day. Ten year-sentences were imposed upon thirty-three of the organization's leaders, five year sentences on thirty-three, one year and one day on twelve defendants, and three days sentences on two others. Cases against Benjamin Schragger, Chicago writer, and Pietro Nigra, Spring Valley, Ill., were continued. All sentences on the four counts in the indictment will run concurrently. Fines ranging from \$20,000 on Haywood and his chief aides, down to \$5,000 were imposed.
