USE OF CITY LIBRARY SHOWS AN INCREASE

Books Taken Out in October 800 in Excess of Same Month Last Year.

Eight hundred more books were taken out of the public library during October, 1923, than in the same month last year, according to figures made public by Librarian Crouch. The total for the month was 29,230 as compared with 28,430 in 1922.

At the main branch of the library, 20,385 books were loaned, of which 9,896 were fiction. The east end 9,896 were fiction. The east end branch loaned 3,294, including 2,101 fiction. Members took 3,042 from the south branch, 1,615 fiction, while in the southeast branch 2,509 books were loaned, of which 1,623 were fic-tion. The reference department was well patronized, 2,534 persons using 3,409 books. Pictures totaling 88 were also loaned. were also loaned.

The membership at the library at present is 23,326.


