It seems hardly pessible in these days of quick and easy travel, of competitive transportation, that there should be a coast on Vancouver Island, with a seaboard of over 45 miles that is practically unknown. And this in a temperate country between the latitude of 45 deg. and 55 deg.!

The Canadian Pacific is the only dine to send boats to ply up and down this coast and they only call at the different ports every ten days or so. Otherwise these pioneer settlers have no connection with the outside world unless it be at the end of the Alberni Canal which is so far the only point where the island railway meets the west coast.
