HOLADIN

The Entire Pancreas Gland Extract

In 3 gr. Capsules.

HOLADIN is an extract of the entire pancreas gland, presenting all the constituents both of the digestive and the internal secretion. HOLADIN, whilst possessing great tryptic activity, is of especial potency in respect to the amylolytic and lipolytic enzymes; it is rich in the important cell-constituents, lecithin and nuclein, which peculiarly abound in the pancreas.

HOLADIN is put up in gelatin capsules (automatically filled), each containing approximately three grains. The usual dose is one capsule about three hours after meals, and one at bedtime. In cases of constitutional disease or in serious disorders of digestion attributed to faulty pancreatic functioning, the dose may be gradually increased to two or three capsules at a time.

HOLADIN, by the U. S. P. method or assay, exhibits at least four times the starch converting power of "Pancreatin" U. S. P., 1900, and far exceeds in saccharitying power any diastase of commerce.
