DRAFT OF BILL TO AMEND THE PRESENT MEDICAL ACT.

- Whereke it is experient to appear the Outsire Medical Act, so as to eachly the Council to a oid the expense awarred under the present system of election, and for the purpose of moleng the Penal Clauses nore ejecual them they are ar present, be it their force consoled as follows:
- I. Sections forty, forty-one, forty-two and forty-three archereby repealed, and the following sections and sub-sections are substituted in lieu thereof:—
- II. Any person who shall wilfully presure, or attempt to precure, himself to be registered under the said Act, by making or producing, or causing to be made or produced, any false or fraudulent representation or declaration, either verbally or in writing, shall, on conviction thereof before any justice of the peace, incur a penalty not exceeding one hundred dollars, and overy person knowingly adding or assisting him therein, shall, on conviction thereof, incur a penalty of not less than twenty, nor more than iffly dollars.
- 2. If any person shall procure, or cause to be procured, his registration under the said Act by means of any false or fraudulent representation or declaration, either verbally or in writing, it shall be lawful for the Registrar, upon the receipt of ovidence which shall be satisfactory to him of the falsity or fraudulent character of said representation or declaration, to crase the name of the said person from the register, and to make known the fact and cause of such crasure by notice to be publishand once in the Ontairo Gazette, and after such notice has appeared, the person whose name has been so crased as aforesaid shall cease to be a member of the said College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontairo, and shall cease to enjoy any of the privileges of registration under the said Act, and shall be disqualified from registering under the said Act at any future time without the express sanction of the Council.
- III It shall not be lawful for any person not registered under the said Act to practise Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Ontatio for hire, gain or hope of reward.
 - 2. If any person not registered under the said Act,
