Sir:

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note No. 16 of July 13, 1947, stating that the Government of the United Kingdom undertakes, in respect of Bermuda, Jamaica and the Cayman Islands, to grant reciprocal rights in paragraph 3 of the Annex to that Agreement for a period of four years from the 1st January, 1947, provided that the service provided by the designated airline of Canada is adequate to cater for the requirements of the Government of the Colony concerned. In the event of the designated airline making arrangements for the service, it may make such arrangements as it may deem fit, provided that the service is not inferior to that provided by the designated airline of the United Kingdom.
