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Replacement Parts for Paving Equipment

On June 14th, 1990, Northern Fortress Ltd. requested a panel review of the administrative review decision made by the International Trade Administration of the U.S. Department of Commerce on the margin of dumping on exports of replacement parts for self-propelled bituminous paving equipment from Canada.

Panel proceedings were suspended during December pending the replacement of a Canadian panel list. Under the revised schedule, the Panel decision is due by May 24, 1991.

Induction Motors

Three U.S. companies have requested a Panel review of the October 20, 1990 decision by the Canadian International Trade Tribunal to continue to impose dumping duties on electrical induction motors imported from the USA. The companies had until November 30th, 1990 to file their complaint and the oral argument is scheduled for June 20th, 1991. The Panel decision is due by September 11th, 1991.

Oil Country Tubular Goods

On November 5th, 1990, Stelco Inc. requested a Panel review of a final determination by the International Trade Administration of the U.S. Department of Commerce that modifies the application of anti-dumping and countervailing duty orders on oil country tubular goods from Canada.

Panel selection was completed on December 27th, 1990. However, the review was terminated January 23rd, 1991.

Steel Sheet Piling

On December 19th, 1990, Casteel Inc. requested a Panel review of the anti-dumping administrative review and cancellation of the suspension agreement made by the International Trade Administration of the U.S. Department of Commerce. Panel selection was completed February 12th, 1991, and the Panel decision is due by October 30th, 1991.
