A copy of all reports made to heads of departments, or to His Excellency the Governor General in Council, by any commissioner or commissioners, together with his or their findings in each case; and a statement showing the action taken thereon by any head of a department, or by the Governor General in Council.

12. The name, age, office and salary of any and every person appointed to any office or employment under the Government, in the place of, or in consequence of any person's removal or dismissal, as a result of the finding of any commissioner or com-

missioners.
